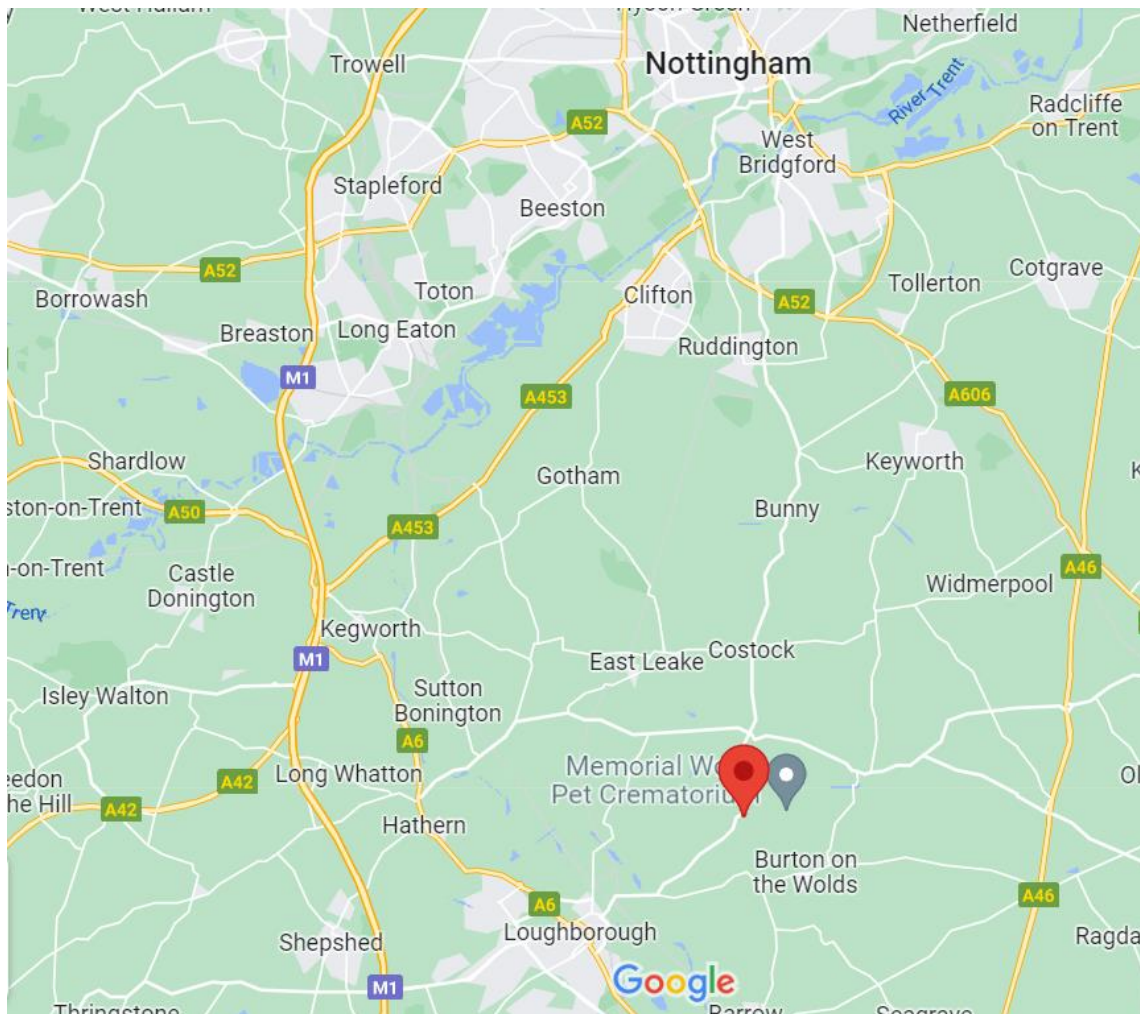

### HER THIRD RELATIONSHIP WAS WITH 'WILLIAM KENDALL'

#### **Family notes:**

*Maria apparently separated from first husband Thomas Watman within a couple of years of marriage, although whether mutual or if not initiated by whom is not known. It would explain why a marriage between Maria and William Kendall has never been located – it likely never occurred. It is worth noting that at the time of her father's death in 1857 (some years after she formed the relationship with William Kendall), her brother Joseph still recorded Maria as Maria Watman on their father's death certificate. Either Joseph (Thomas's son) was unaware of the new relationship, or there was no formal marriage it would seem. Met William Kendall about 1852 (although if married is unknown). In the early 1850's, they moved to Paarl, about 50 km (30 miles) from Cape Town. Where the next six children were born. In 1864 the family moved to Onehunga, New Zealand where the last two of ten children were born.*

#### **From the family bible...**

*My brother William is now living at a village near the cape of Good  
Hope Africa He married a woman That came from the Island of saint Helen  
And has at this time 3 boys and a girl  
Has gone with his family to New Zealand, have not heard anything of them for several years  
1874 not heard of Brother William yet  
In 1876 just heard that Brother W Kendall Is Dead in New Zealand Died about"*

***"George Kendall died Oct 12 1886  
Interred in Sutton Churchyard My Grandfather "***

**Note: The last two lines was written by George Kendall, grandson of William's eldest brother George, and is in reference to George, eldest brother of William and grandfather to the George Kendall who wrote it.**

**Family oral history** had long suggested that William originated from Nottingham where his family was involved in the lace trade. This has now been proven correct. His parents married at Bullwell, Nottinghamshire, and by the time of William's birth had moved northwards to Hoton. While his parents later moved back south again, back to Lenton south

*of Bulwell, (both villages then in the country, but now incorporated as outer suburbs of Nottingham city).*

*The 1851 census shows William's parents George and Sarah and his sister Sarah as living in a street of lace makers and garment makers, with George a ... knitter (1851 UK census - first word difficult to decipher.)'*

### **Family written history for William...**

*In the early 1850's Maria Mittens married William Kendal (although no marriage record has been found and it would appear that Maria may still have been married to Thomas William WATMAN, as he did not die until 1888). Charlotte was born about 1847 at Cape Town the father is unknown (most likely, Maria was unwed). Michael Thomas was born in 1850 in Cape Town, the son of Maria and Thomas William WATMAN. In the early 1850's Maria and William KENDALL got together and with Charlotte and Michael Thomas, they moved to Paarl, about thirty miles from Cape Town, where another six children were born to Maria and William KENDALL and William worked variously as a labourer and as a prison guard at the local prison. The last two children (making ten all told) were born at Onehunga, New Zealand after the family's move there.*

*What brought on the decision to move from South Africa to New Zealand can only be guessed at today. The feeling is that it was because of Maria being an African. Mixed marriages were certainly frowned upon back then by the British and William may have felt that life would be better in New Zealand, where mixed white/Māori marriages were looked upon much more favourably. There it would be easier to pass Maria off as a Māori, or if not her then certainly the children. In any event late in 1864, the family boarded the Eveline and sailed for New Zealand, where they settled at Onehunga, living in Church St.*

***Our ancestors,** William and Maria Kendall, arrived in Onehunga, Auckland from the Cape of Good Hope on 22 January 1865. Settled in Onehunga, living in Church Street. Her parents were freed slaves, and it is thought that she at some time went to South Africa where she married William. He was a Constable with the prison at Paarl and was a mason on arrival in New Zealand, from whom we are all descended - with their children Charlotte (Australia); Tom (Raglan); George William (Hokianga); William Harry (Auckland); Sarah (died in childbirth); Maria (died as a child); Mary Jane (Auckland) and James (Dunedin).*

***William Kendall's** health apparently started to deteriorate after their arrival in New Zealand since he apparently had an inflammation on the lungs about 1865 from which he never totally recovered. On 19/6/1873 he was admitted to the Auckland Lunatic Asylum suffering from "Melancholia". He was discharged as "relieved" on 7/11/1873 but was re-admitted the following year. He died at the Asylum on 29/5/1875. Maria apparently made ends meet by working as a washerwoman. She died 23/2/1877. Both are buried at St Peter's Church, Onehunga.*

*William and Maria are buried in the Churchyard of St Peter's Anglican Church, Onehunga, but with seemingly uncalled for modernisation of the church, their headstone has been moved. The church authorities, in their wisdom, have laid it flat down with the inscriptions uppermost, and this apparently will be their permanent position. Naturally, even in the short space of time that this has happened, the weather beating down upon the headstone has alarmingly deteriorated the condition of the stone, and much worse, the lettering thereon is becoming indecipherable.*



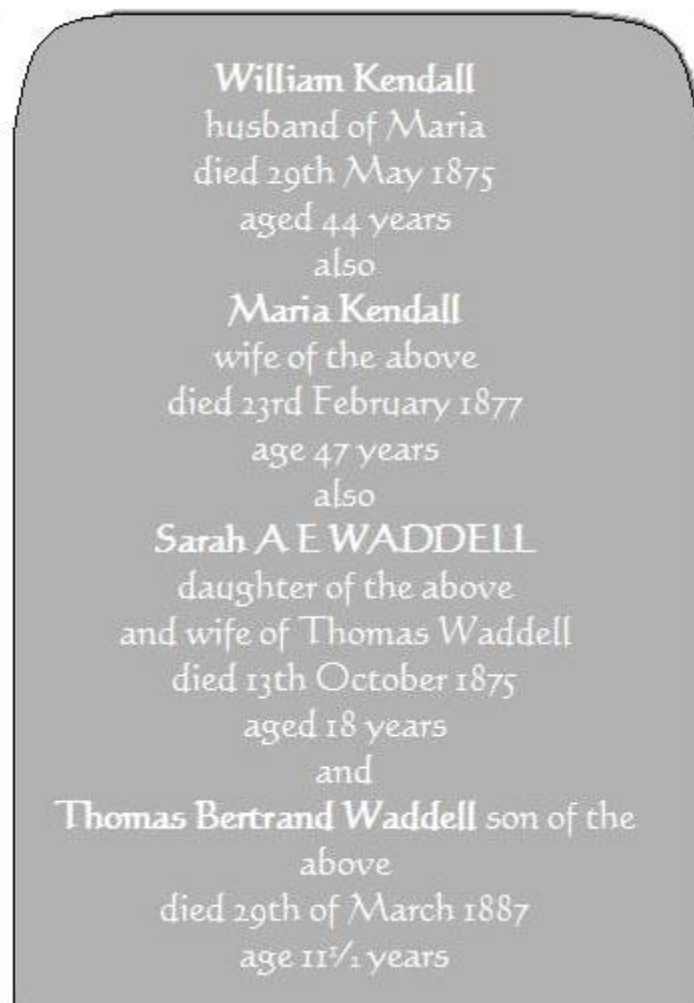

**Compilers notes:** It has been suggested that William was with the British army in Natal, South Africa from 1851-1853. At some stage soon after he met Maria Mittens and started a family.

Later they moved to Paarl, about 50 km (30 miles) from Cape Town where six of their children were born. He worked as a prison officer (constable) at the local prison.

During 1867 they caught the good migration ship 'Eveline' from Cape Town to New Zealand.

In 1843 the 45th served in South Africa during the Cape Frontier Wars (1811-1858), when the native Xhosa tribes rose in armed rebellion against continuing European rule and the Orange River Expedition. In 1865 the Regiment successfully petitioned to have the title of 'Sherwood Foresters' added and became the 45th (Nottinghamshire) (Sherwood Foresters) Regiment of Foot. In 1868 the Regiment took part in the Expedition to Abyssinia against the Ethiopian Emperor Tewodros II who had imprisoned several missionaries and two representatives of the British Government, and the expedition was described as 'one of the most expensive affairs of honour in history.' 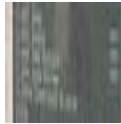

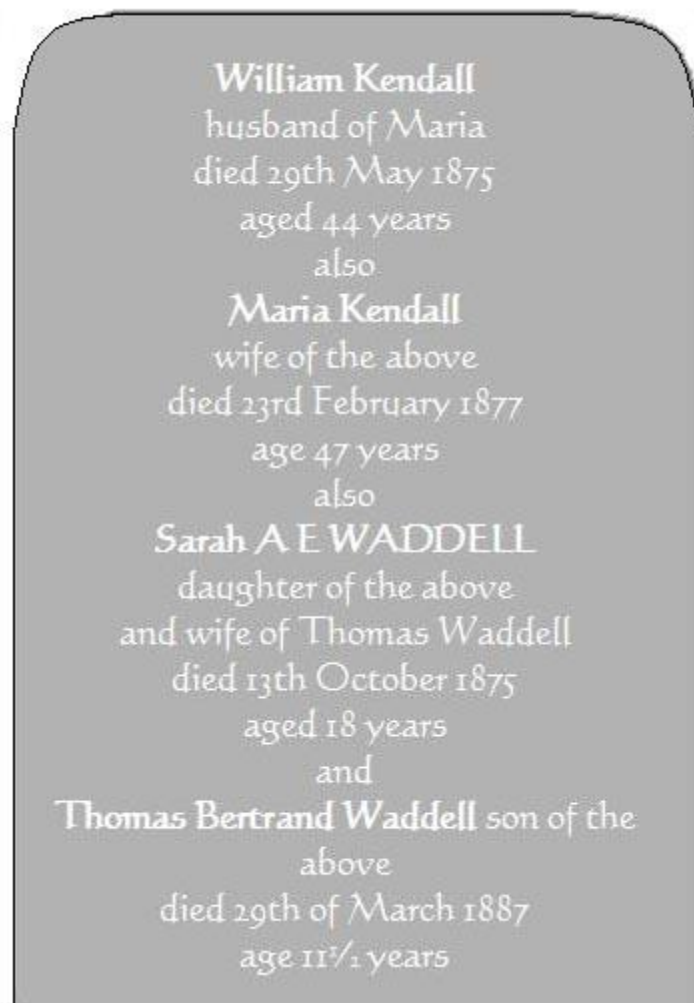

**STOREKEEPER'S SAFE.**

Timo Tane, a Maori youth, pleaded not guilty to having broken into the shop of George William Kendall at Metemete, near Hokianga, on April 18, and stolen £20 and a certain other coin.

Mr J. R. Lundon defended.

Kendall, in evidence, said he left his safe unlocked one night, and on opening up the store in the morning he found it nearly empty, and quantities of small change missing from other places in the shop. Among the missing money from the safe was a large coin—a four or five shilling piece, which he had had for seven years. Entrance had evidently been gained to the store by heavily pushing the double door. A bundle of notes in the safe to the value of £50 was overlooked by the thief.

Ngaripa Tawiopao, a relative of accused, said he got a cheque cashed by accused, who gave him a quantity of sixpenny and threepenny pieces.

Isabella Titar said she received from the accused the large coin produced.

### Notes for Arthur Kendall from a Māori Newspaper...

The following text is taken from Te Pipiwharaua – He Kupu Whakamarama, No. 43. This is a Māori newspaper published in September 1901 in Gisborne and the phrase appears on Page 2 within an article headed Turupa Aata Kanara (Trooper Arthur Kendall).

*“He uri no nga ewa ra nunui, kiwhainga, hohourongo. Ko tona tupuna I hinga ki te whainga I muri whenua, I tu I te tao, ki tona taha mau; no reira I huaina ai tona ingoa hapu ko te Tao-Maui.”*

*TURUPA AATA KANARA. (Trooper Arthur Kendall.) KI TE PIPIWHARAUROA. ## Death of a returned soldier.

AUCKLAND, Saturday.— The funeral of Gunner Arthur Kendall, of Hokianga, late of the Fifth Contingent, who died on the troopship Tagus, left Little's residence, Hobson Street, to-day; the body was taken by train to Onehunga and thence by boat to Hokianga, where the interment will take place; the body has been embalmed.

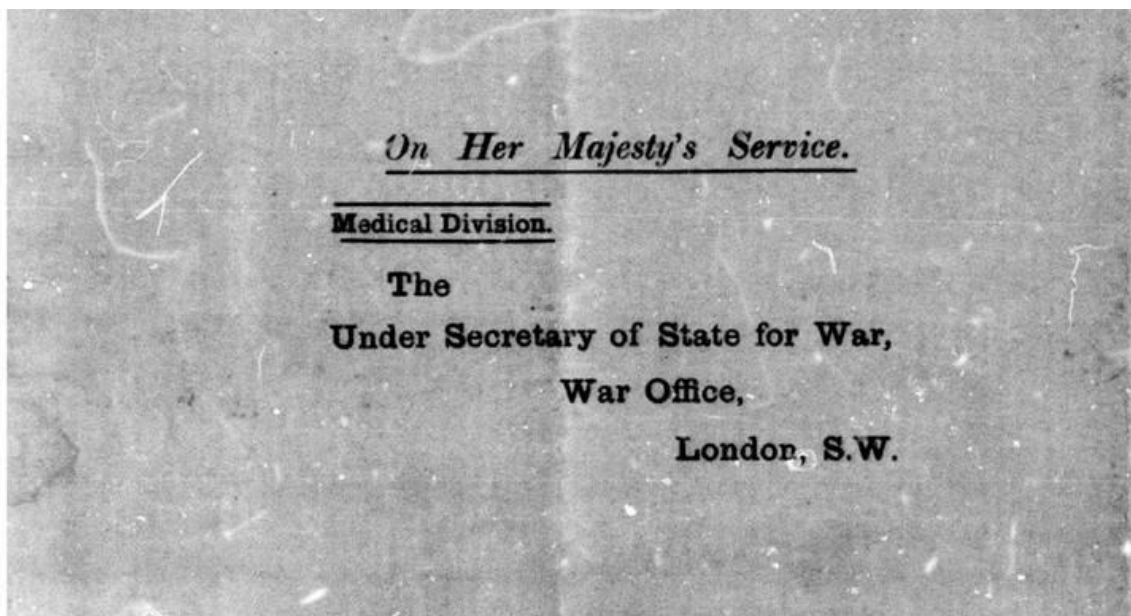
A Hokianga correspondent of Te Pipi-wharaua gives a very interesting sketch of the life of the late Trooper Arthur Kendall (Aota Kanara), who died on the Tagus, and whose body was taken home. He was descended from a good Ngapuhi family. When in South Africa he refused to see his friend buried in the unceremonious method of being wrapped in blankets, and from the benches of a Boer church he made a rude coffin for the body of his friend, and laid him to rest in respectability in the lonely veldt. At his funeral the old Maori women, who loved the lad, could hardly suppress their feelings, and on seeing Aota's old corps they mournfully cried out his name, as though he was in the ranks.

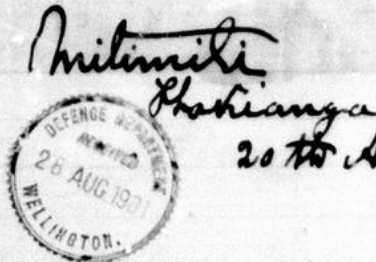

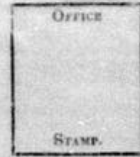

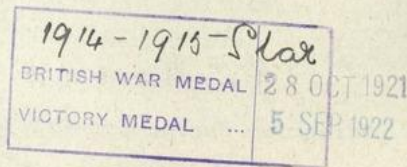
