CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

CONJECTURAL ONLINE WHAKAPAPA / GENEALOGIES FOR THOSE VERY EARLY SETTLERS OF THE HOKIANGA. AN EXAMPLE FOLLOWS FOR...

'JOHN BAKER' AND HIS WHANAU / FAMILY

Note: John had an English wife who died before immigrating to NZ. It was said they had a daughter called Elizabeth who accompanied her dad to this far off land where he hung his hat in the Hokianga District of Northland New Zealand from about 1820.

ADDRESSING THE VALIDITY OF ONLINE GENEALOGIES...

Note: Over the past twenty or so years there has been many conjectural genealogies and a lot of hearsay floating around online for those very early First Nation People and European settlers, other than missionaries, who abounded the Hokianga Harbour of New Zealand between 'let's say' 1800 and 1850. Government registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages were not required legally until about 1840 for the Europeans, and for the 'First Nation People' not until about 1900. So, finding official documentation (*the birth right of these characters, their standing in society and or the country of their makers*) is quite difficult at times, however not impossible as you will find in this journal...

Hearsay

Written and or word of mouth 'HEARSAY' is the silent curse for a genuine genealogist as it fixes mixed messages between legend and the actual and can sometimes make researching for the truth quiet frustrating but can also add a flourish of color and interest to what is actual. However, the truth is best when compiling a genealogy and the compiler of this journal does his very best to pass over the knowledge as it really was.

An example of hearsay: James (John) Baker had arrived in New Zealand from Ireland in 1828. He was born in 1794 and died in 1869. This was James' (John's) second marriage. A daughter (Elizabeth) by his first wife (name not known) supposedly before he came to New Zealand, was born in 1818. Elisabeth married Thomas Hollingsworth and died in 1854.

More hearsay: About John Holroyd (James/Haki) Baker He was a Sawyer and helped build the first Catholic church at Purakau at Hokianga (this was moved to Te Ti)

John Baker (Holroyd)was actually the son the Earl of Sheffield. He had a disagreement with his father and immigrated to New Zealand with his first wife. He changed his name to his grandmother's name Baker dropping the Holroyd name. Indeed in 1909 a

commission came to New Zealand looking for descendants and the family received payments from the UK Chancery well into the 1930's.

Well, there is a big question mark over this family history. The think is that when John Baker bought land in NZ of which he did quite a bit in his trading - he signed his mark. So he couldn't read or write. A bit odd for a son of an Earl not to be able to read and write. Some decedents believe he as a prisoner in Sydney who got his ticket of leave and became a Sawyer in NZ. But all needs to be verified whatever the story is like ship records? But there are lots of land records relating to Hokianga and script in Auckland. The church was in Parakau and was moved to Motiti not far from Pangaru. Worth a visit. (Sandra Jenkins)

Bio notes: Mere Maro appears to have been John's second marriage. A child by his first marriage, 'Beti' (probably Elizabeth) was born in 1818 and married Thomas Hollingsworth. Beti died 1854?

Note: The John Baker family genealogy (No1) is a fine example of many genealogies online which have been doctored up to make believe that ancestors of a given named person were famous or wannabe famous. As far as our John Baker is concerned it makes no sense and is conjecture only.

For a start the name used is John James 'Holroyd-Baker', but it is noted in the next genealogy (No2) shown from familysearch.com that their surname was 'Baker-Holroyd'. Genealogy (No1) gives the birth of John James as January 1793, and his mother was Lucy Pelman. However, Lucy did not have any children and she didn't marry the Earl until Dec 1794 nearly two years after the mythical 'John James Holroyd Baker' was born.

Genealogy (No1) also suggests that 'John Baker' was born in Ireland of English Aristocracy and not England as some punters have suggested ...but was our John educated to the standard of this family? (Some have said that he signed official documents with an X here in New Zealand.)

It is time enough, to put to rest the legends and the myths of this man 'John Baker' of the Hokianga. They are very colourful and interesting but that is all they are... The reader can decide for themselves as the compiler unearths the family history of this man and his family in this following named journal which will be posted on www.kaihuvalleyhistory.com in due course ...

Historical questions often asked are: Was **Mary Gear** who married **William Gear** about 1853 the daughter of **Elizabeth Hollingsworth nee Baker** who was historically claimed by many as the English daughter of **John Baker** who lived in the Hokianga, New Zealand from the about early 1820's...

After extensive research for this following family thread, the compiler of this research journal has observed that we are looking at four different maiden surnames for the **Mary** above who married **William Gear** about 1853 in New Zealand. These names were recorded in separate **William Gear family records** for that period from 1850 to about 1900, as follows...

- 1/. Mary Hollinsworth
- 2/. Mary Allensworth
- 3/. Mary Ellensworth
- 4/. Mary Houldsworth

'It is obvious that the people who recorded her maiden surname in various records, couldn't spell or were drunk'.

The compiler has also observed that we are also looking at three different *William Gear* families for that period between 1820 and about 1860, as follows...

- 1/. 'William' who was born about 1820 and lived in the Northern Wairoa, New Zealand. He was a soldier and possibly had his family in the 1840's.
- 2/. And our William who was born about 1826 and was a Sawyer in 1853 when he was married by the Missionary James Buller at Tangiteroria, Northern Wairoa, New Zealand to Mary Allensworth. This William had his family in the early 1850's.

The compiler has decided that the thread which works best for Lynne Cowan is number three, the William Gear who married Mary Allensworth in 1853 and had only one officially recorded child called 'Louisa' born about 1854.

'Louisa would continue the thread for her family which would eventually lead to our **'Lynne Cowan'** of today...'

3/. Then finally 'William' born about 1831 who possibly lived in the South Island of New Zealand who had his family in the 1860's.







Mr. Ross presented a petition from William Gear, who stated that he was discharged from the 58th Regiment in December, 1859, and remained in the province ever since, but had never received any gratuity, either in land or money. He, therefore, prayed that the usual privilege might be granted to him as accorded to other regiments, namely, a gift of forty acres of land.

Petition received and laid upon the table.

Mr. Ross also presented a petition from William Cox, of Maungatapere, Wangarei, who stated that he had been discharged from the 58th Regiment on the 31st day of July, 1857, after a service of 12 years and 345 days, and which discharge he had obtained for the purpose of settling in the province of Auckland. He prayed that the Council would see fit to make a grant to him of 40 acres of land.






